TEACHER'S DAY (S. RADHAKRISHNAN'S BIRTHDAY), 5th September


"The way you teach, the knowledge you share, the care you take, the life you shower, makes you the best teacher in the world. "

Happy Teachers' Day to all who taught us something or the other in our lives!




INDEPENDENCE DAY, 15th August

International Day of Yoga is celebrated every year on 21st June to raise awareness worldwide about the importance and impact of yoga on the health of people.


The concept of International Yoga Day was proposed by the respected Prime Minister of India, Mr. Narendra Modi.


National Science Day (NSD), 28th February
