Report On One Day Workshop on Awareness Programmme

REVISED ACCREDITATION FRAMEWORK (RAF) of NAAC

Addressing the changing paradigms of higher education, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bengaluru developed Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF) to make the existing assessment and accreditation process more robust, objective, and transparent, outcome oriented and stakeholder friendly.

It is in this context, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Lucknow Public College of Professional Studies (LPCPS) organized a one day workshop under the theme, "NAAC Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF)" on 29th April, 2019. In all, participants attended the workshop. These included Dean LPCPS, IQAC Coordinators, and 10 faculty members of the college.

Inaugural Session

Dr. L.S. Awasthi, Dean Academics, LPCPS welcomed all the guests and participants and briefed the participants about the objective and rationale of the workshop. He informed that the Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC has necessitated documentation of the details on all aspects related to Curriculum, Teaching-Learning, Student Support, Research, Infrastructure, Governance etc. He further expressed a hope that Lucknow Public College of Professional Studies would come forward for assessment and accreditation as an immediate outcome of this workshop.

Technical Session I

In this session, Prof. Rajiv Manohar, Director IQAC, University of Lucknow, made a detailed presentation on the Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC. He explained minute details of the Assessment & Accreditation (A & A) process beginning with the eligibility criteria to online submission of 'Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA)'.

Next, he described as to how the HEI's applying for A & A process for the first time (Cycle1 Process) has to register and proceed. He informed that "IIQA User Manual" is available on the dashboard for help. Also, the required documents and the ones to be uploaded were also enlisted. The IIQA Application Process was explained in detail. Thereafter, Prof. Rajiv Manohar discussed the changes introduced in the Revised

Assessment and Accreditation (A&A) Framework in July 2017, representing an explicit paradigm shift making it ICT enabled, objective, robust and transparent. Subsequently, Prof. Rajiv Manohar explained all the seven Criteria to serve as basis for assessment of HEIs in detail. The Key Indicators, including the New Introduced ones, were also explained with suitable examples.

Prof. Rajiv Manohar concluded by saying that each and every data should be supported with verifiable document, therefore utmost care should be taken before submitting the SSR.

Technical Session II

In the post tea session, Dr. Mahendra Agnihotri, Assistant Professor, University of Lucknow, deliberated upon "Peer Team Visit". He told the participants that in the revised framework, the number of Peer Team members and duration of visit has been reduced. Dr. Mahendra Agnihotri, cited many examples how any false information mentioned by the college in SSR is revealed by the Peer Team. He, cautioned, that such practise is not acceptable and the college should always submit only that information which could be verified. He also made it clear that the Peer Team is not for grievance redressal, therefore, the faculty, employees and students during interaction with Peer Team should put forth answers honestly and desist from forwarding their personal grievances.

Open Session



8. COMMEMORATIVE EVENTS

The College strongly believes that unless the present generation of youth are sensitized about the significance of the festivals of our secular country and the sacrifices which great men and women of this country have made for uplifting their countrymen, the students are not able to understand their responsibility to the nation. Our students are on a mission towards better India by breaking the boundaries of religion and caste. Thoughts of great Indian personalities are sowed into the young minds through the exhibitions and programs conducted on these days. The unity in which India has its diversity that serves as the melting pot of cultures, religion, and ethnicity and develops qualities of tolerance and understanding amongst students. The college practices pluralist approach towards all religions functions and encourages the students and faculty to showcase the same. Every year our institution organizes the National/International commemorative days, events and festival. Staffand students get to know the importance of national integrity in the country in general and theirrole in it in particular.

Following activities are organized by staff and students of the college by initiating many of the below mentioned events: conducting lectures, meetings, and exhibitions, conducting awareness, distributing published materials, conduct outreach programs and support the needy commemorating the leaders by establishing prizes and awards.

- 1. 12th January National Youth Day (Swami Vivekananda Birth Anniversary): He was the inspiration of youth and hence his birth anniversary is also celebrated as National Youth Day in the country. Swami Vivekananda gave an important contribution in giving a modern and inspiring interpretation of Hinduism and spirituality. Hewas born in 1863 in Kolkata.
- **26**th **January Republic Day:** Republic Day is celebrated on January 26 to commemorate the adoption of constitution. On this day, various formal events including flag-hoisting and march-past are organized and which are followed by "constitution awareness program" in which students and staff members get information of their duties towards our nation and rights given to them by our constitution. By organizing such type of events, the college does its share to arouse patriotism and awareness in next generation.
- 3. 28th February National Science Day (Sir C V Raman): National Science Day is celebrated in India with the objectives of commemorating the first Nobel prize in India on Science which was achieved by the discovery of Raman Effect by Sir C V Raman. It is also celebrated to emphasize on the culture of science and the application of science for the welfare of people. As a part of the National Science Day celebration, IIT Kanpur organizes thematic workshops on different subjects every year.

- **4. 8th March-International Women's day:** International Women's Day is a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women. Theday also marks a call to action for accelerating gender parity. Significant activity is witnessed worldwide as groups come together to celebrate women's achievements or rally for women's equality. LPCPS celebrates this day with zeal and gusto.
- **14th April Ambedkar Jayanti:** Ambedkar Jayanti or Bhim Jayanti is an annual festival observed on 14th April to commemorate the memory of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar, Indian polymath, the father of the Constitution of India and civil rights activist. It marks Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's birthday, who was born on 14 April 1891. Since 2015 it has been observed as an official public holiday throughout India. Ambedkar Jayanti is celebrated not justin India rather all around the world. Basic objective of this program is to percolate and developthe Philosophy and Principles of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar through his thought.
- **21st June International Day of Yoga:** This day is being celebrated throughout the world annually since June 2015 with an objective to bring about awareness about the healthbenefits of yoga and its several practices. The aim of this day is to educate people about the physical, mental and spiritual benefits that can be derived by practicing yoga. As LPCPS special yoga sessions are organized to spread awareness.
- **7. 15th August-Independence Day**: It is a grand event marked with the flag hosting by the Chief Guest and well-practiced march-past by many teams of Security Personnel. Cultural activities related to independence movement are exhibited.

8. 5th September -Dr. Sarvepalli RadhaKrishnan Birth Anniversary:

On 5th September, we celebrate Dr. Radhakrishnan's birthday as Teacher's Day with great fervor. The students organize a programme for the teachers and the Guru-Shishya parampara is celebrated.

2nd October- Gandhi and Shastri Birth Anniversary - A standout amongst the most mainstream events in India and one of the three national occasions, Gandhi Jayanti is praised in our college on 2nd October to stamp the birth commemoration of Mahatma Gandhi. Gandhi Ji is known as the Father of our Nation, Bapu or basically Mahatma. The day is announced as a national occasion and all institutions and workplaces celebrates in many ways. The standards of truth, peacefulness and trustworthiness are recalled and generally plugged among the students of the institution.

Lal Bahadur Shastri Jayanti is also celebrated on October 2. It marks the birth anniversary of Lal Bahadur Shastri who served as the second Prime Minister of India. Lal Bahadur Shastri was an important figure during the freedom struggle and rose to prominence after independence. He led the country during the Indo-

Pakistan War of 1965 and his slogan "Jai Jawan, Jai Kisan" became very popular during the war. He died on January 11, 1966. He wasposthumously awarded the Bharat Ratna.

10. 31st October Rashtriya Ekata Divas (Birth Anniversary of Sardar

Patel) - In 2014, the Government of India introduced Rashtriya Ekta Diwas or National Unity Day with an aim to pay tribute to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on his birth anniversary this day is celebrated as National Unity Day. The day commemorates the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. He played an important role in uniting India.

11. 11th November - National Education Day – (Maulana Abul Kalam

Azad Birth Anniversary): National Education Day is an annual observance in India to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first education minister of independent India, who served from 15 August 1947 to 2 February 1958. National Education Day of India is celebrated on 11 November every year. The National Education Day is celebrated in schools annually by spreading awareness about the importance of education. This is done by conducting interesting seminars, activities, working on projects, writing essays and more.

- 12. 19th November- Rani Laxmibai Jayanti: The Queen of Jhansi, Rani Lakshmibai, was famously known as Rani of Jhansi. Rani Lakshmibai was one of the leading figures of the Rebellion of 1857 which began on May 10, 1857. For the entire nation, she became an icon for the freedom struggle against the British Raj for Indian. November 19, the birth anniversary of Rani Lakshmibai, is celebrated as Martyr's Day in Jhansi to honour the liveslost in the Rebellion of 1857.
- 13. 26th November National Constitution Day- (Dr. B. R. Ambedkar):

Constitution Day (Samvidhāna Divasa), also known as "National Law Day", is celebrated in India on 26 November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26 November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted to the Constitution of India, and it came into effect on 26 January 1950. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on 19th November 2015 notified the decision of Government of India to celebrate the 26th day of November every year as 'Constitution Day' to promote Constitution values among citizens.

1st December-International AIDS Day: World AIDS Day takes place on 1 December each year. It's an opportunity for people worldwide to unite in the fight against HIV, to show support for people living with HIV, and to commemorate those who have died from an AIDS-related illness. Founded in 1988, World AIDS Day was the first ever global health day.




INDEPENDENCE DAY

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


2nd OCTOBER 2018
