## **DEAN ACADEMICS MESSAGE**



The fee in annexure 2 will be as per the norm of LPS (Lucknow Public School)

- Scholarship will be provided on merit basis and on a first come first serve basis.
- 5. The scholarship offered by LPCPS shall be for the complete duration of the respective program of the student e.g. in case of BBA the scholarship shall be applicable to the students for all 3 years of the program. However subject to good conduct and continuous good academic performance of the student.
- 6. The details of tuition fee attached as Annexure 1 (above).
- Embassy shall invite applications from eligible Vietnamese students every year through its own channel and after shortlisting, the list of recommended students along with scholarship recommendations shall be sent to LPCPS.
- 8. Final allocation of scholarship will be decided by LPCPS based on the students.
- On completion of the due formalities for their registration by the student, LPCPS shall issue to the student the Conditional Offer Letter, containing all details for Visa Purpose.
- 10. The student shall be responsible for applying the student visa at the nearest Indian High Commission in Vietnam at his/her own cost. LPCPS shall provide all the necessary documents as per the requirement of the High Commission.
- 11. On grant of visa the student shall intimate Embassy and LPCPS about his/her travel plans and LPCPS shall arrange to pick up the student from Lucknow CCS Airport or Lucknow ISBT/Railway Station.





- 12. Registration fee of US\$ 100 is waivered off for the students coming via embassy.
- 13. LPCPS shall provide the Vietnamese students English foundation program (worth US\$ 300) at no additional cost. The foundation course will be mandatory to all Vietnamese students.
- 14. Hostel Facility: The hostel facility shall be optional for the students and in case opted for Hostel, students will have to pay the charges as applicable along with US\$ 250 refundable security deposit. The hostel fee shall be paid annually by the student.
  - It is not mandatory for students of Vietnam to stay in our hostel. They can stay outside campus at their own risk. College will not be liable for any problem faced outside.
  - In Private Accommodation the whole responsibility will be of their own.
- 15. It is mandatory that each student shall be medically insured for the entire duration of stay in LPCPS. The cost of the same shall be borne by the student (s).
- 16. The admission will only be considered confirmed when the student has deposited the fee with LPCPS as per rules.
- 17. Refund Policy is subject to existing rules and regulations by LPCPS/University of Lucknow. The refund policy is as follows:



The unity in which India has its diversity that serves as the melting pot of cultures, religion, and ethnicity and develops qualities of tolerance and understanding amongst students. The college practices pluralist approach towards all religions functions and encourages the students and faculty to showcase the same. Every year our institution organizes the National/International commemorative days, events and festival. Staffand students get to know the importance of national integrity in the country in general and theirrole in it in particular.

Following activities are organized by staff and students of the college by initiating many of the below mentioned events: conducting lectures, meetings, and exhibitions, conducting awareness, distributing published materials, conduct outreach programs and support the needycommemorating the leaders by establishing prizes and awards.

- 1. 12th January National Youth Day (Swami Vivekananda Birth Anniversary): He was the inspiration of youth and hence his birth anniversary is also celebrated as National Youth Day in the country. Swami Vivekananda gave an important contribution in giving a modern and inspiring interpretation of Hinduism and spirituality. Hewas born in 1863 in Kolkata.
- 2. 26th January Republic Day: Republic Day is celebrated on January 26 to commemorate the adoption of constitution. On this day, various formal events including flag-hoisting and march-past are organized and which are followed by "constitution awareness program" in which students and staff members get information of their duties towards our nation and rights given to them by our constitution. By organizing such type of events, the college does its share to arouse patriotism and awareness in next generation.
- **3. 28th February National Science Day (Sir C V Raman):** National Science Day is celebrated in India with the objectives of commemorating the first Nobel prize in India on Science which was achieved by the discovery of Raman Effect by Sir C V Raman. Ambedkar, Indian polymath, the father of the Constitution of India and civil rights activist. It marks Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's birthday, who was born on 14 April 1891. Since 2015 it has been observed as an official public holiday throughout India. Ambedkar Jayanti is celebrated not justin India rather all around the world. Basic objective of this program is to percolate and developthe Philosophy and Principles of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar through his thought.
- **21st June International Day of Yoga:** This day is being celebrated throughout the world annually since June 2015 with an objective to bring about awareness about the healthbenefits of yoga and its several practices. Gandhi Ji is known as the Father of our Nation, Bapu or basically Mahatma. The day is announced as a national occasion and all institutions and workplaces celebrates in many ways. 10. 31st October Rashtriya Ekata Divas (Birth Anniversary of Sardar Patel) - In 2014, the Government of India introduced Rashtriya Ekta Diwas or National Unity Day with an aim to pay tribute to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on his birth anniversary this day is celebrated as National Unity Day. The day commemorates the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. He played an important role in uniting India.

#### 11. 11th November - National Education Day – (Maulana Abul KalamAzad Birth

**Anniversary):** National Education Day is an annual observance in India to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first education minister of independent India, who served from 15 August 1947 to 2 February 1958. National Education Day of India is celebrated on 11 November every year. The National Education Day is celebrated in schools annually by spreading awareness about the importance of education. This is done by conducting interesting seminars, activities, working on projects, writing essays and more.

- 12. 19th November- Rani Laxmibai Jayanti: The Queen of Jhansi, Rani Lakshmibai, was famously known as Rani of Jhansi. Rani Lakshmibai was one of the leading figures of the Rebellion of 1857 which began on May 10, 1857. For the entire nation, she became an icon for the freedom struggle against the British Raj for Indian. November 19, the birth anniversary of Rani Lakshmibai, is celebrated as Martyr's Day in Jhansi to honour the liveslost in the Rebellion of 1857.
- 13. 26th November National Constitution Day- (Dr. B. R. Ambedkar): Constitution Day (Samvidhāna Divasa), also known as "National Law Day", is celebrated in India on 26 November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26 November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted to the Constitution of India, and it came into effect on 26 January 1950. The Ministry of SocialJustice and Empowerment on 19th November 2015 notified the decision of Government of India to celebrate the 26th day of November every year as 'Constitution Day' to promote Constitution values among citizens.







