### Day: One

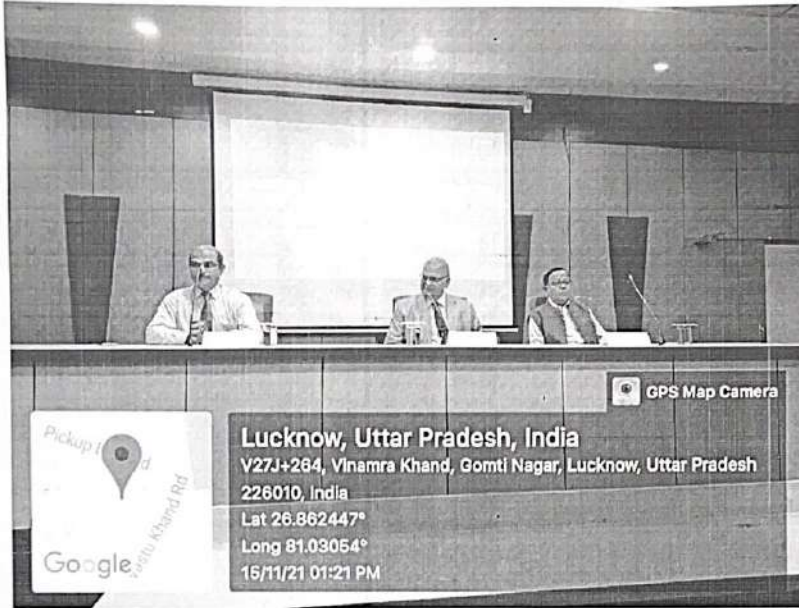

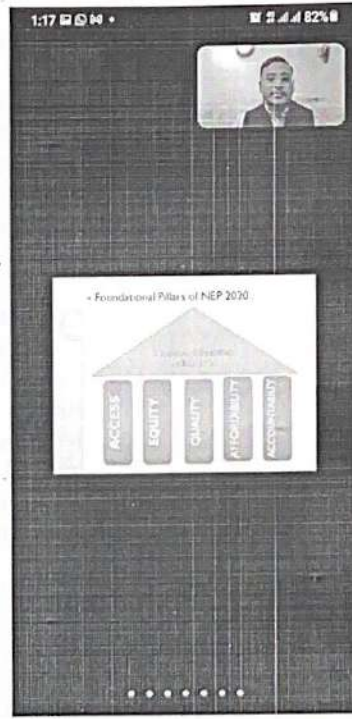

## Day: Three

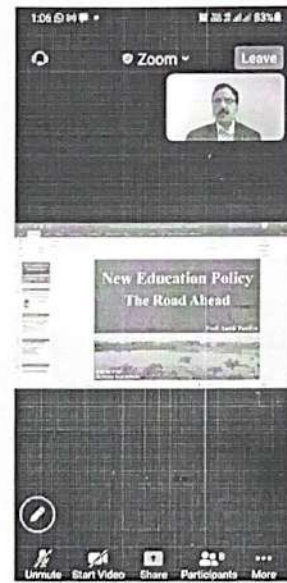

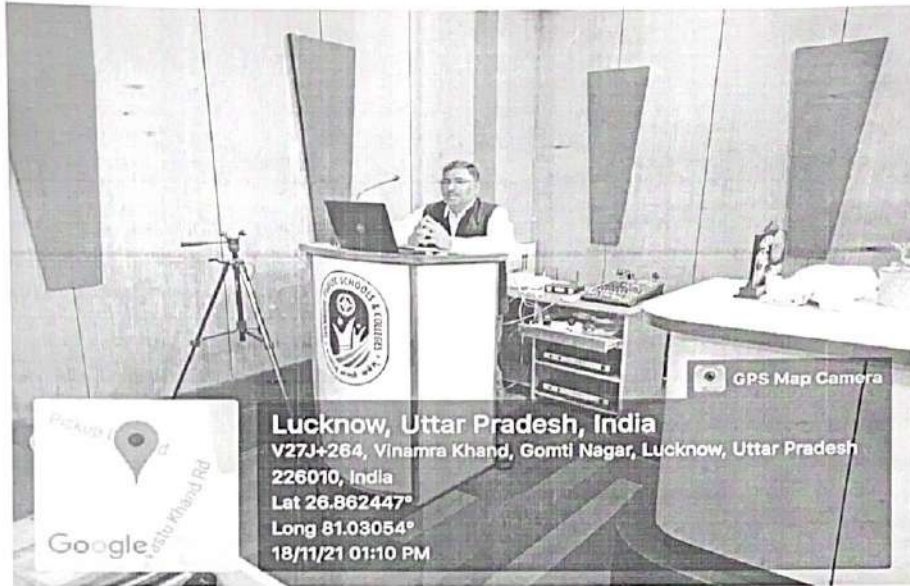
1. Research Universities,

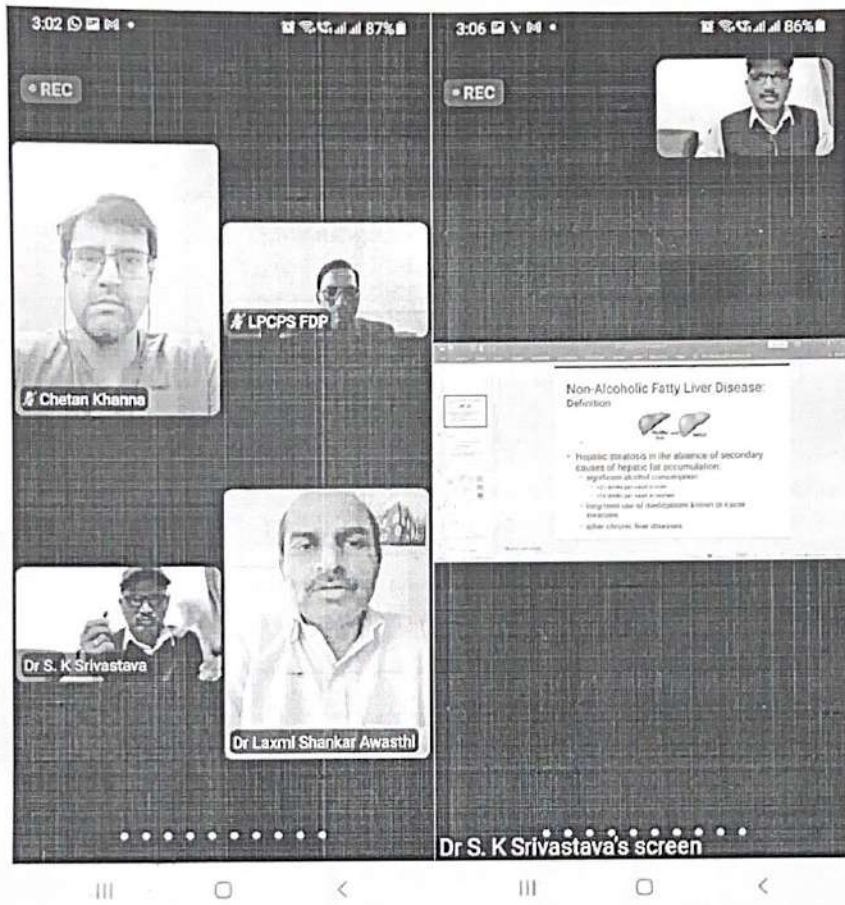
## Day: Five

## Day: Six

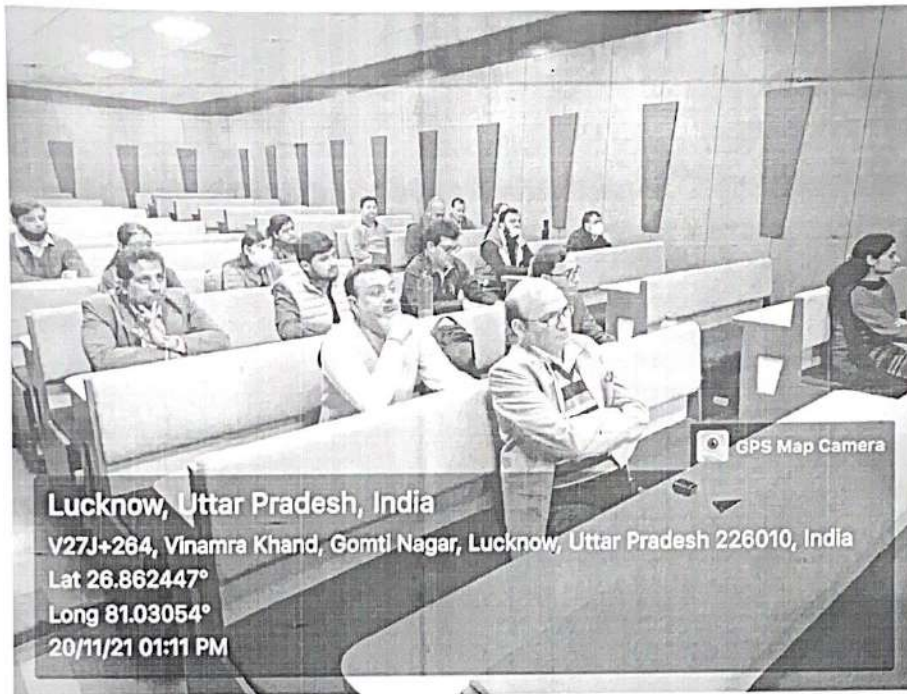

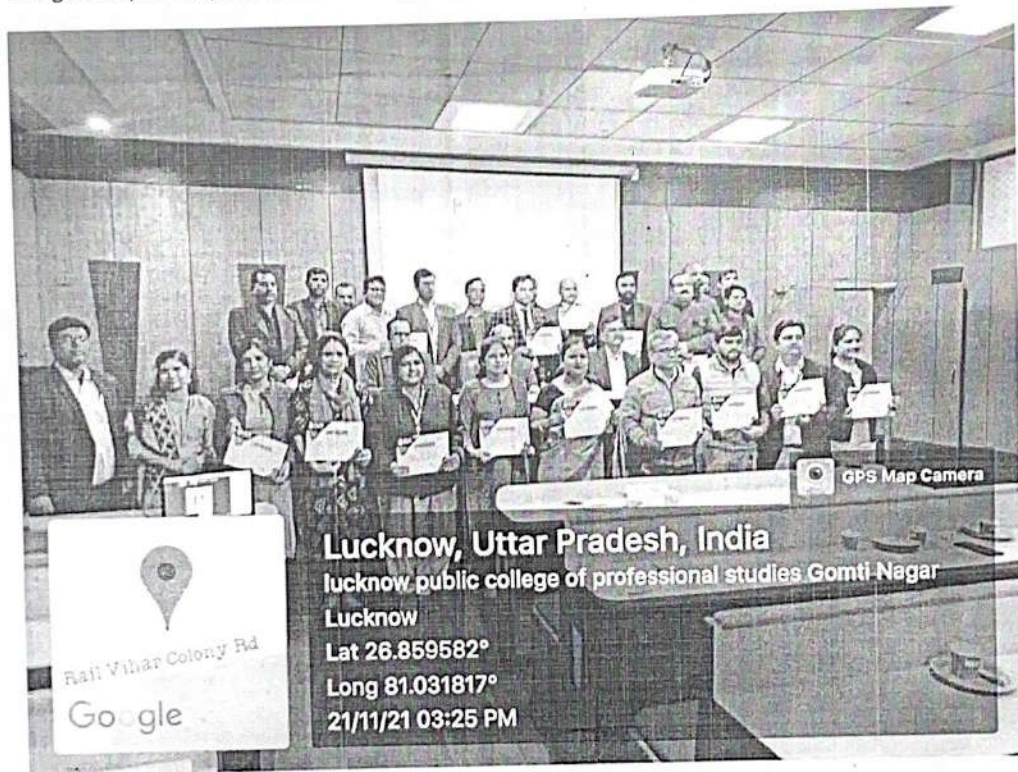
