- The 2nd Internal Examination for these same courses took place in December 2023, reinforcing our commitment to continuous assessment.

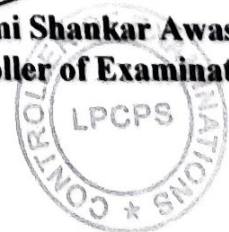
Even Semester Examinations:

Average pass percentage of students in the academic session 2023-24:

$$\text{Percentage per year} = \frac{\text{Total number of final year students who passed in the university examination}}{\text{Total number of final year students who appeared for the university examinations}} \times 100$$

$$\text{Percentage per year} = 493/503 * 100 \\ = 98.01$$
