





Harmony in India.


Topic 2: The Role of Education in

Date: 1st Dec, 2023




Christmas is an annual festival commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ, observed primarily on December 25 as a religious and cultural celebration among billions of people around the world.



Date: 12th Jan, 2024






LOHRI


Date: 16th Jan, 2024


LUCKNOW PUBLIC COLLEGE OF PROFESSIONAL STUDIES REPUBLIC DAY
