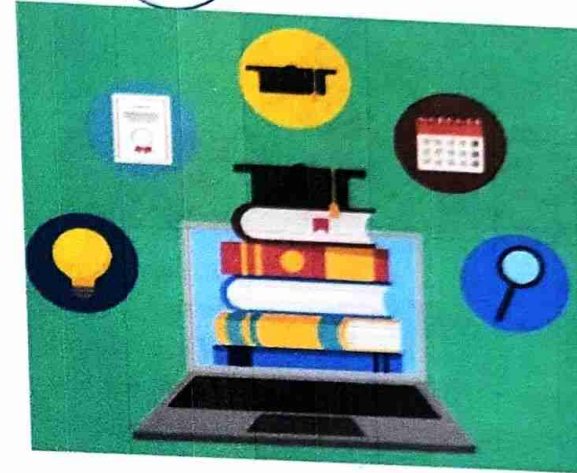

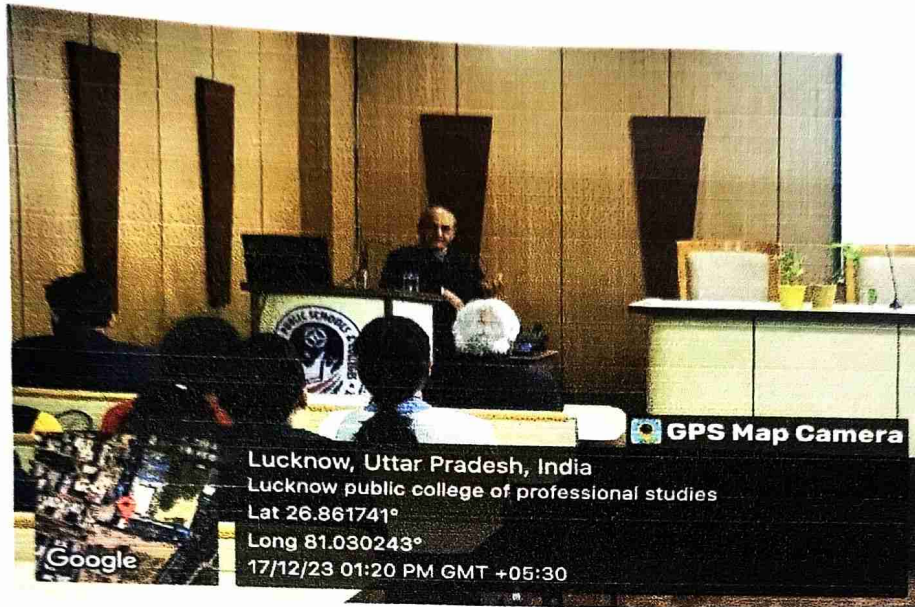

Prof. Dr. D. P. Agrawal told that Once you get a complete grip on this examination and gain some experience, you can slowly follow tougher timetables. - 1. Stick to the UPSC Syllabus** -As the syllabus is observed to be exhaustive and lengthy, covering all topics for both Prelims and Mains is important. Make the syllabus your checklist, as it will help you plan your time well, and you will be able to complete the syllabus before the exam.
- 2. Choose the Best UPSC Books**- Always choose quality over quantity. There are hundreds of books and study materials on the internet. Research and select the best IAS books to aid your home preparation. The books you choose should cover the whole syllabus and must be easy to understand.
- 3. Revision is Important**- No matter how smart you are, if you do not revise, you will lose your chance at qualifying for the exam. Because there is too much to learn, make time for revision.
