






GANDHI JAYANTI (02 OCTOBER, 2023)











REPUBLIC DAY (26 JANUARY, 2024)

The family of Lucknow Public College of Professional Studies pay the true tribute to the father of the nation. His life, thoughts and sacrifices are an inspiration for every Indian.









AMBEDKAR JAYANTI (14 APRIL, 2024)
