LPCPS steps forward to promote this discovery and importance of this day amongst our society. Dr. Abhay Shankar Pandey led a session on the same.



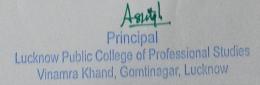


INTERNATIONAL WOMENS DAY (08 March, 2024)

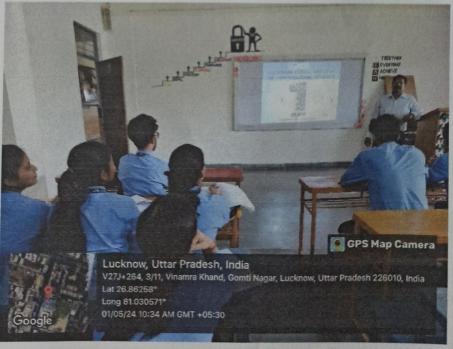




LABOUR DAY (01 May, 2024)
