## Day 3, 13 January 2024



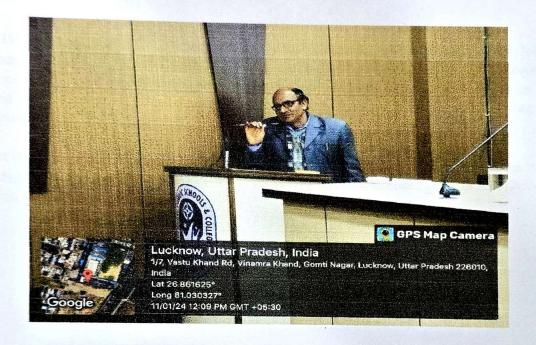

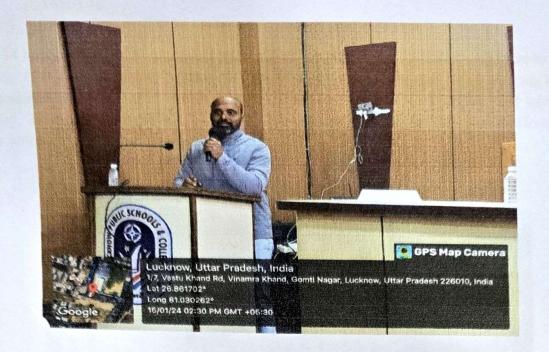

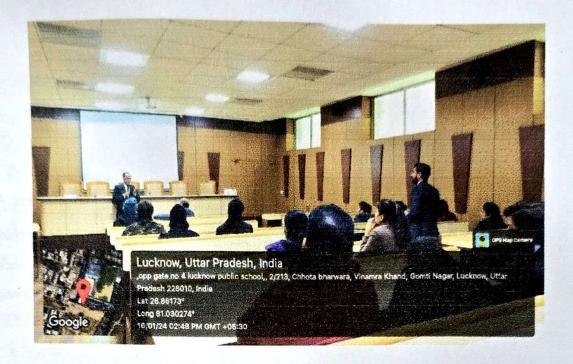
