

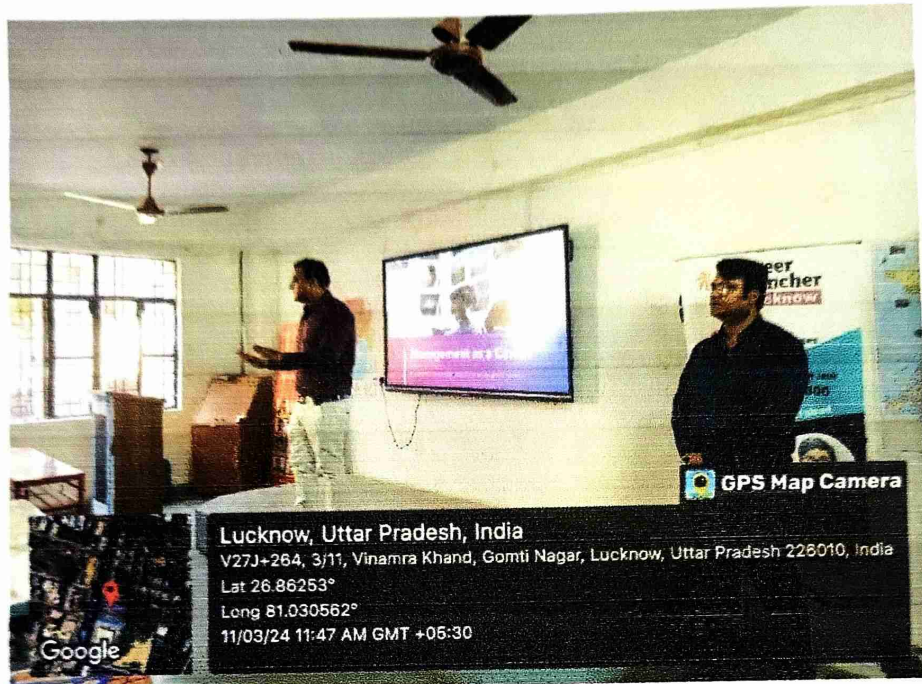

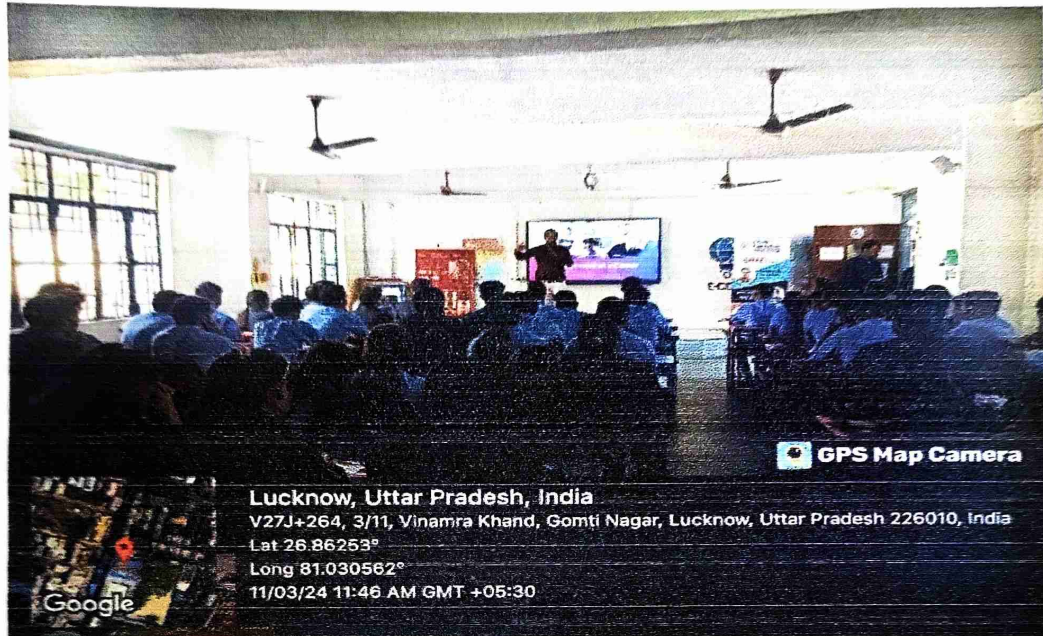

Fears of loss, making a mistake, and financial instability can lead to paralyzing inaction or hasty decisions. Moving beyond these fears is crucial on the road to financial freedom. It begins by acknowledging your fears and understanding they are based on limiting thoughts that can be dispelled. Yes, we have to learn as we go and be wise with financial decisions, but fears (false evidence appearing real) are just based on our thoughts and don't need to stop us. Your life goals and financial goals should align and support each other. Start by identifying your long and short-term goals in different areas of your life, such as career, relationships, health, personal growth, and lifestyle. If you're still discovering what those goals look like for you, read our article about Getting Clarity & Finding Your Purpose. For many people, examples of short-term goals could include paying off credit card debt, going on a holiday, or saving for a down payment on a house.
