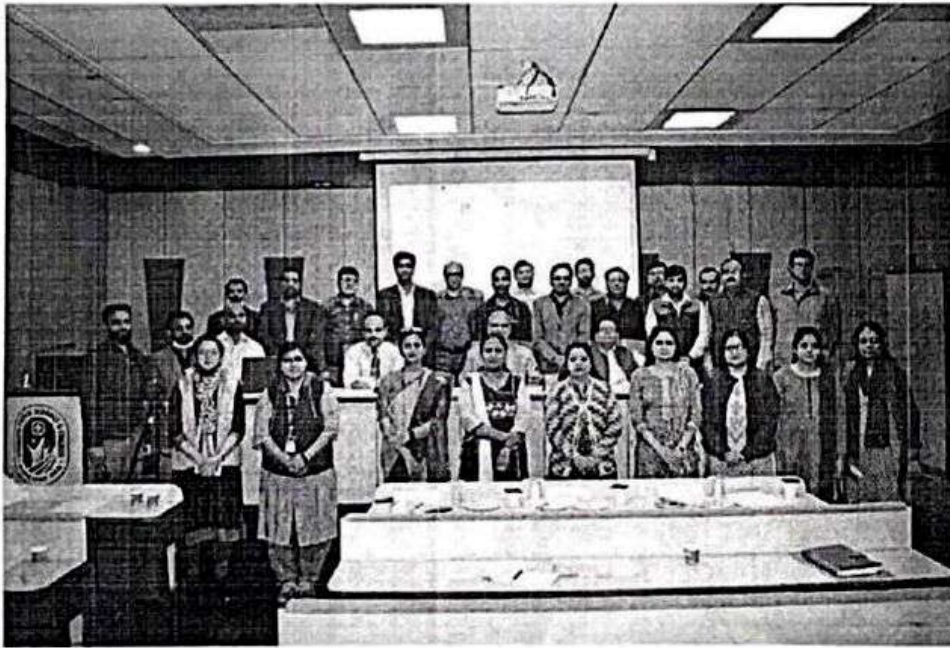
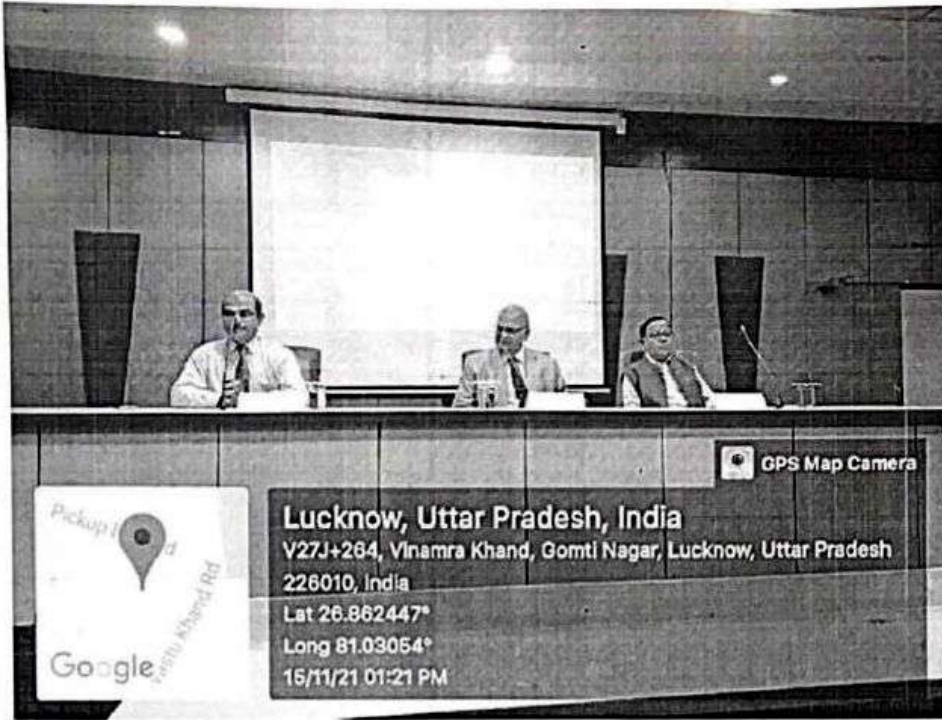

National Educational Policy-2020 is a transformational concept. The FDP commenced with the seeking of the blessings of Goddess Saraswati. The welcome address was followed by an address by the expert speaker Mr. Alok Ranjan.

Dr. Alok Ranjan, in his address said that India has the potential to become a good destination for Higher Education. He said NEP is envisaged to help teachers modernize their teaching style and inculcate innovative and effective pedagogical practices to impart concepts and information in a meaningful and interesting way among the learners to help them learn more deeply and effectively. These teaching-learning methods involve eight steps: observation, question, hypothesis, aims, method, results (data and analysis), discussion, and conclusion. Imbibing research culture in teaching and learning will not only motivate the student for higher-order learning but will also develop an exploratory attitude that will bring a conceptual consistency in acquiring knowledge.

The expert speakers for the Day Two were

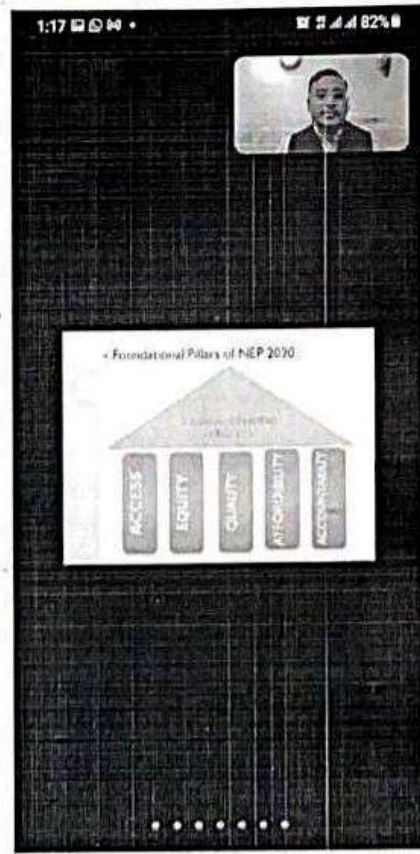

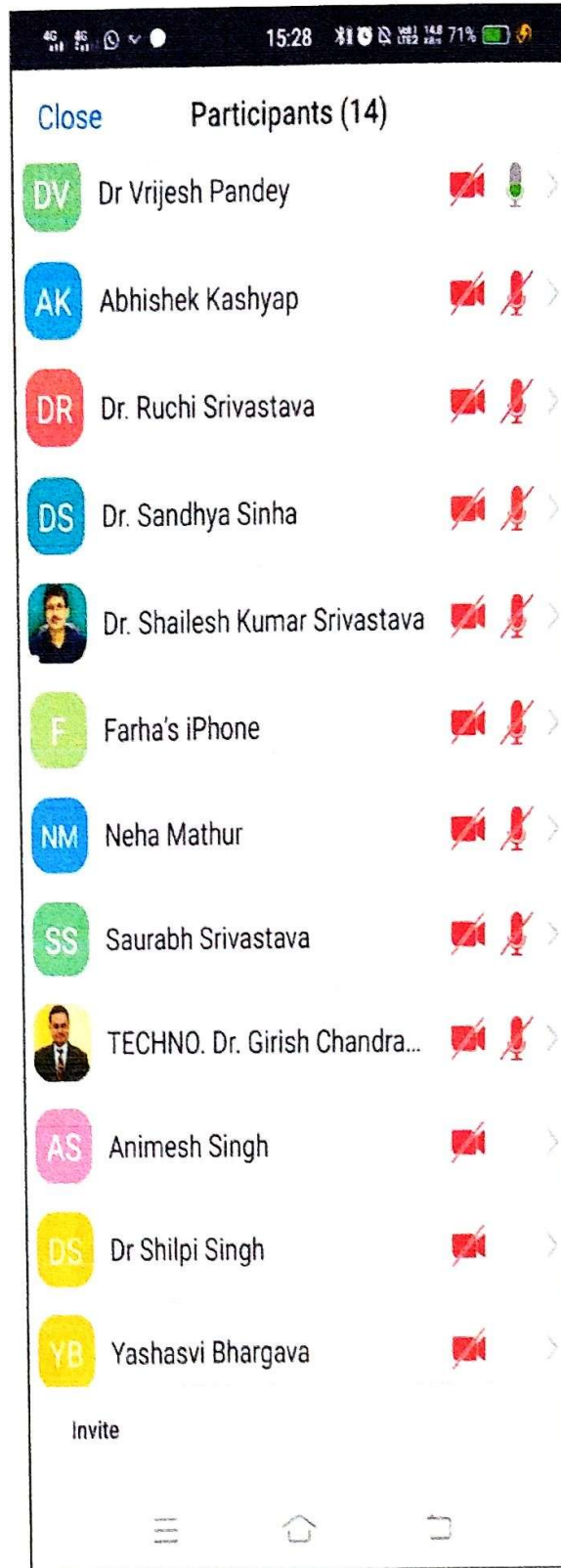
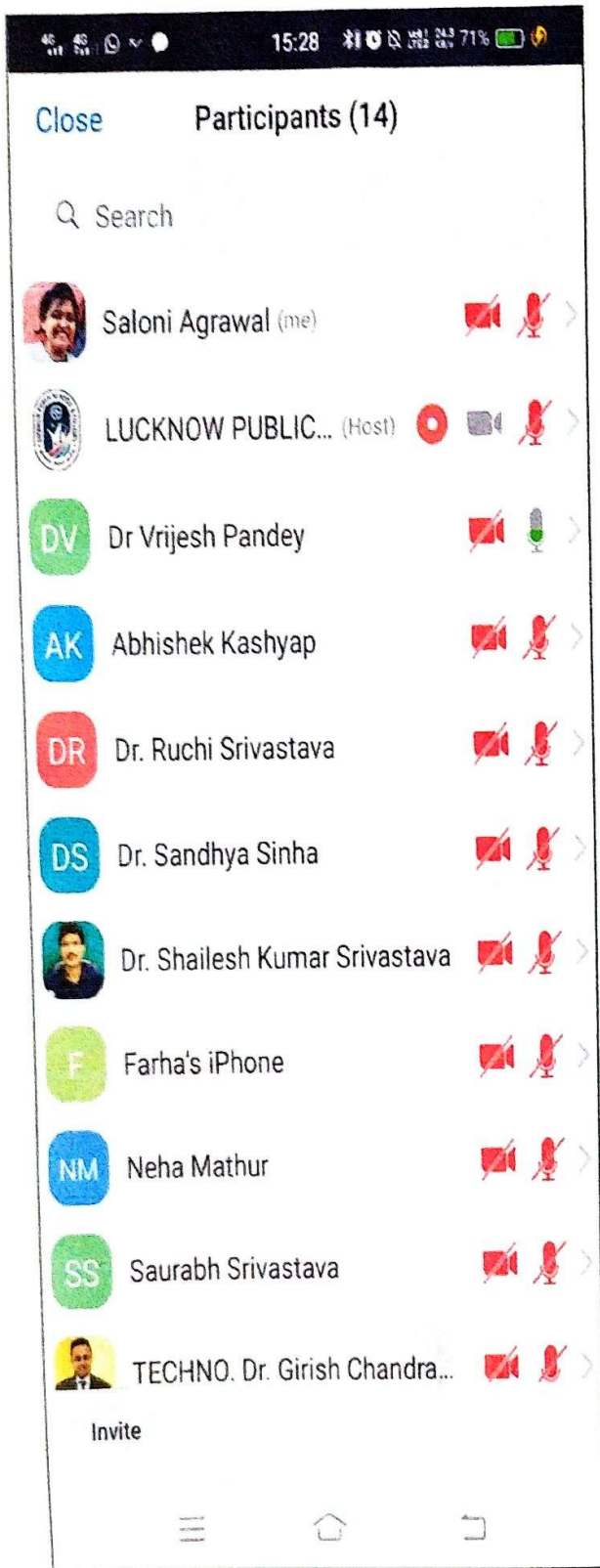

6. Challenges to be met.

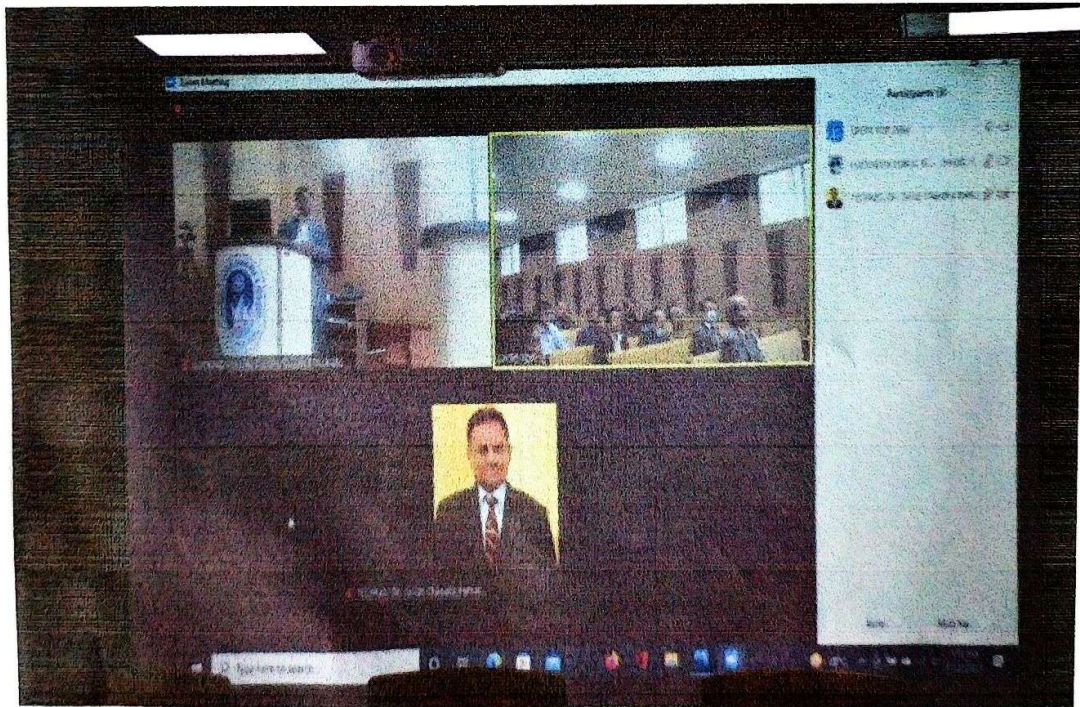

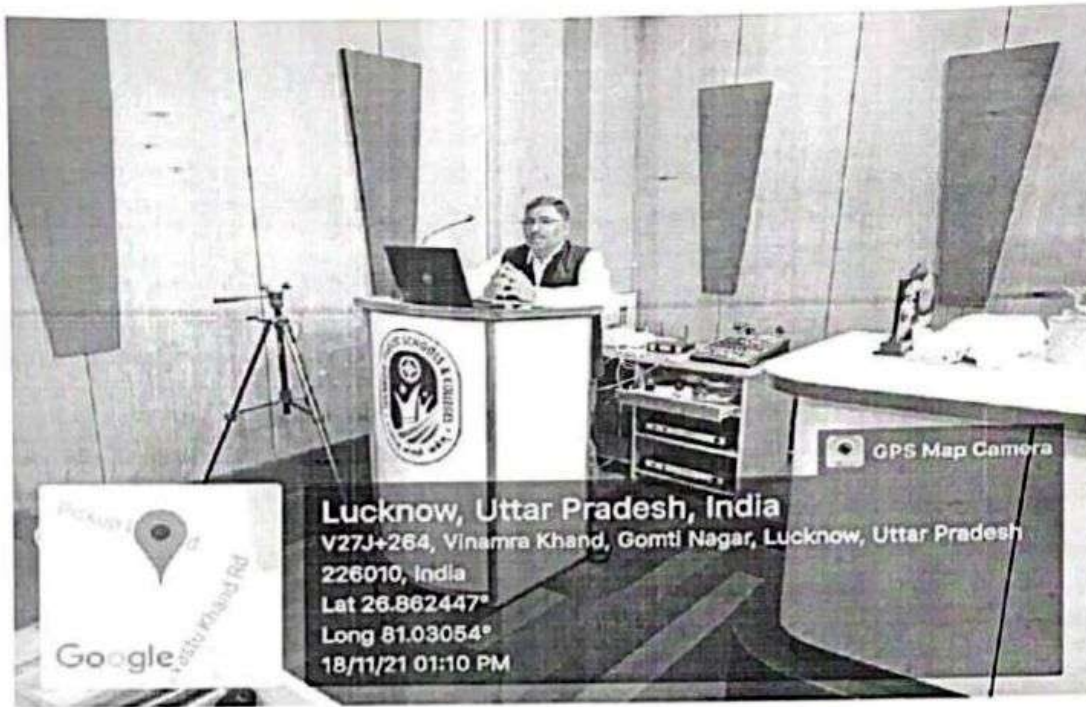
1. Research Universities,
