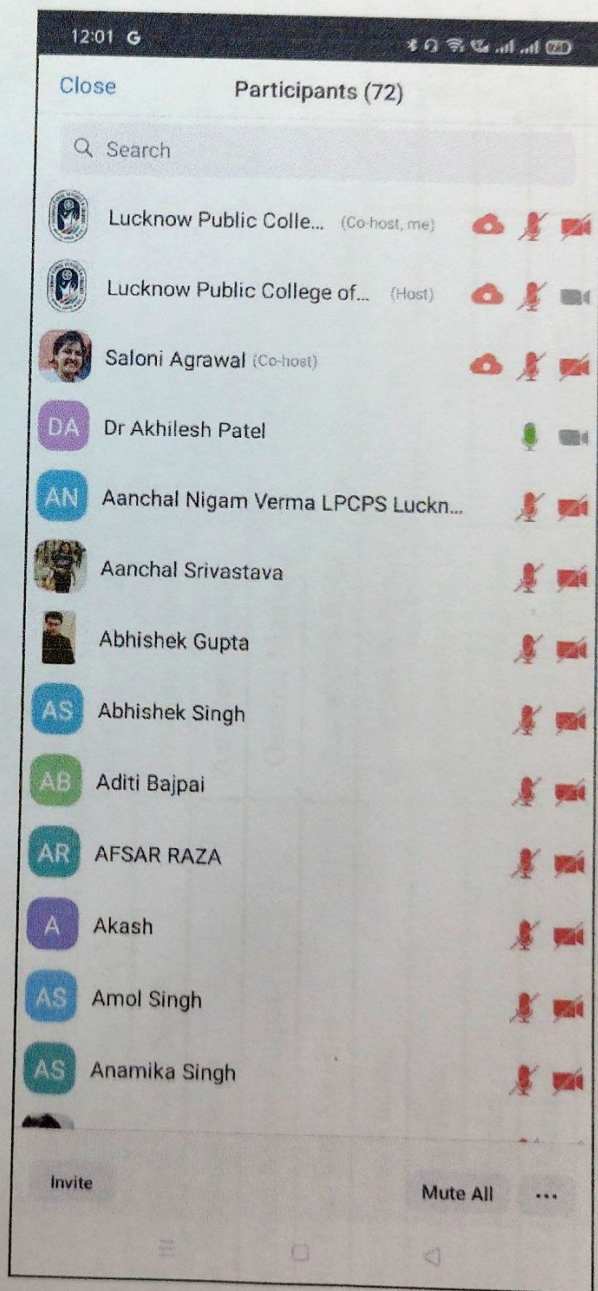
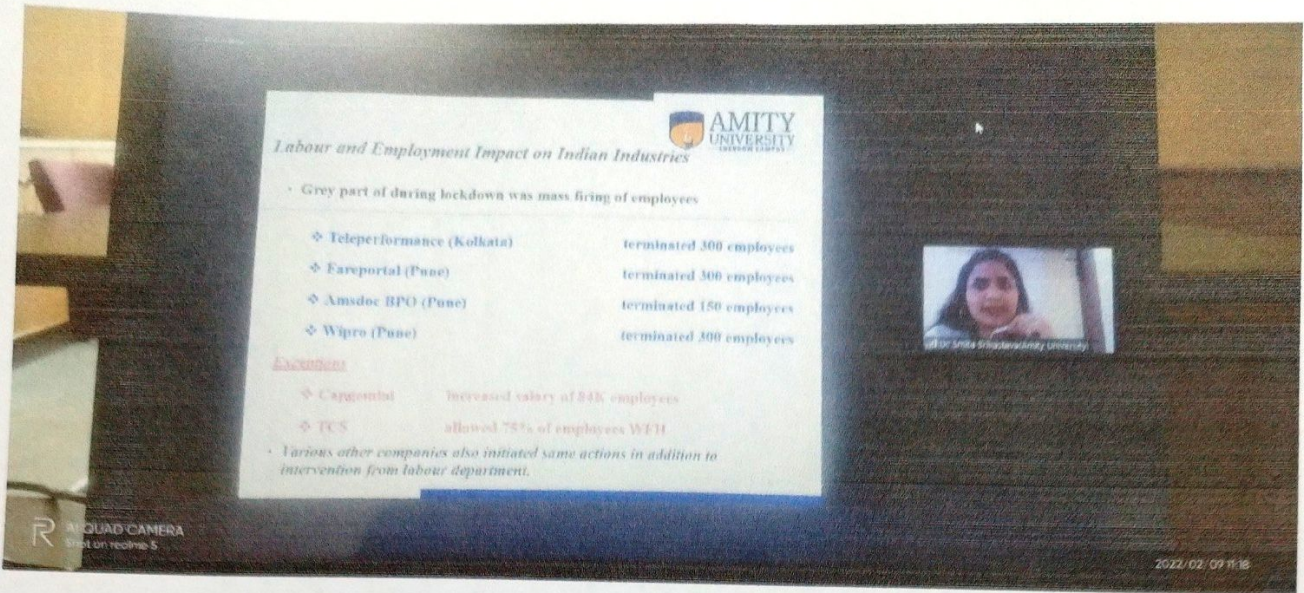
Best Paper award was given to Dr. Shailesh Srivastava for which a certificate and a reward prize of Rs. 1500 was given to him as a token of appreciation.
