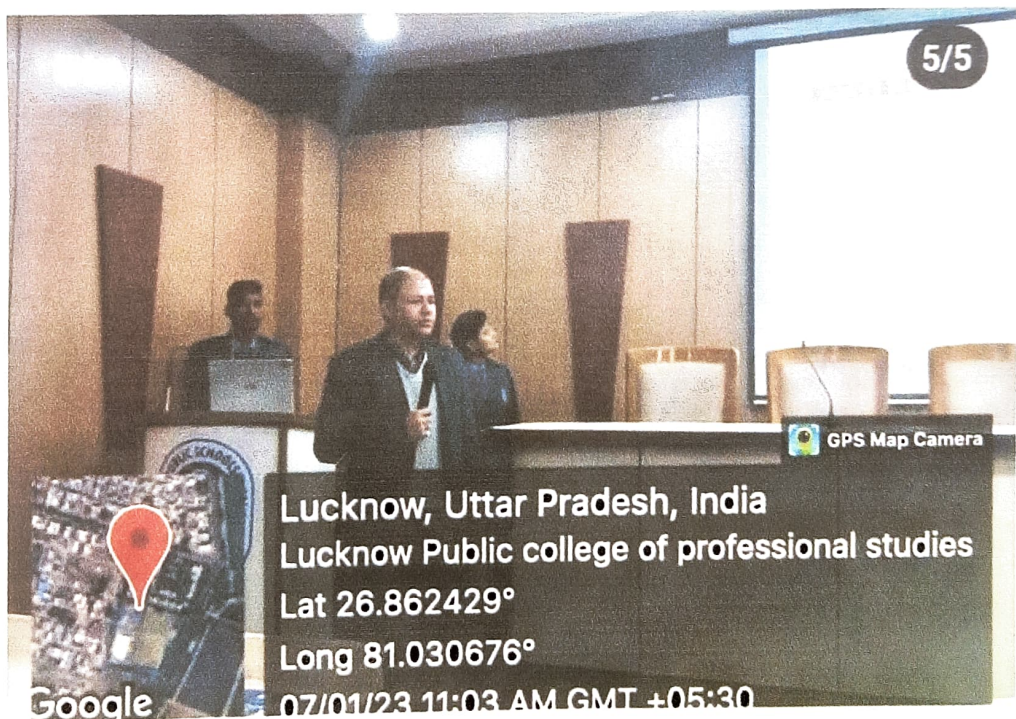

The NSS wing of LPCPS along with the Anti- Ragging Committee of LPCPS conducted a session on 'Ragging is a Crime' on 7th January 2023.

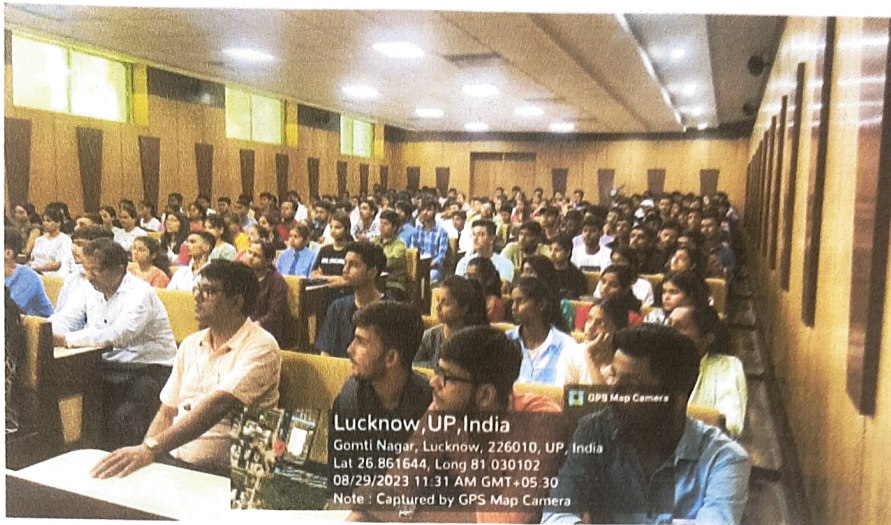

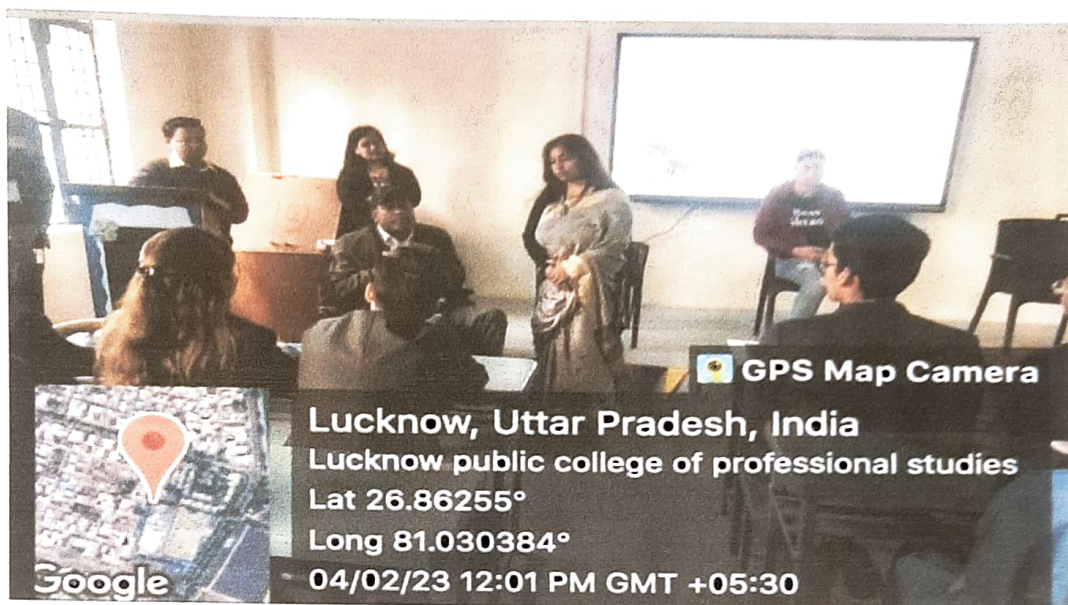
