## Awareness Campaign on Menstrual Hygiene in Dallokhara Village



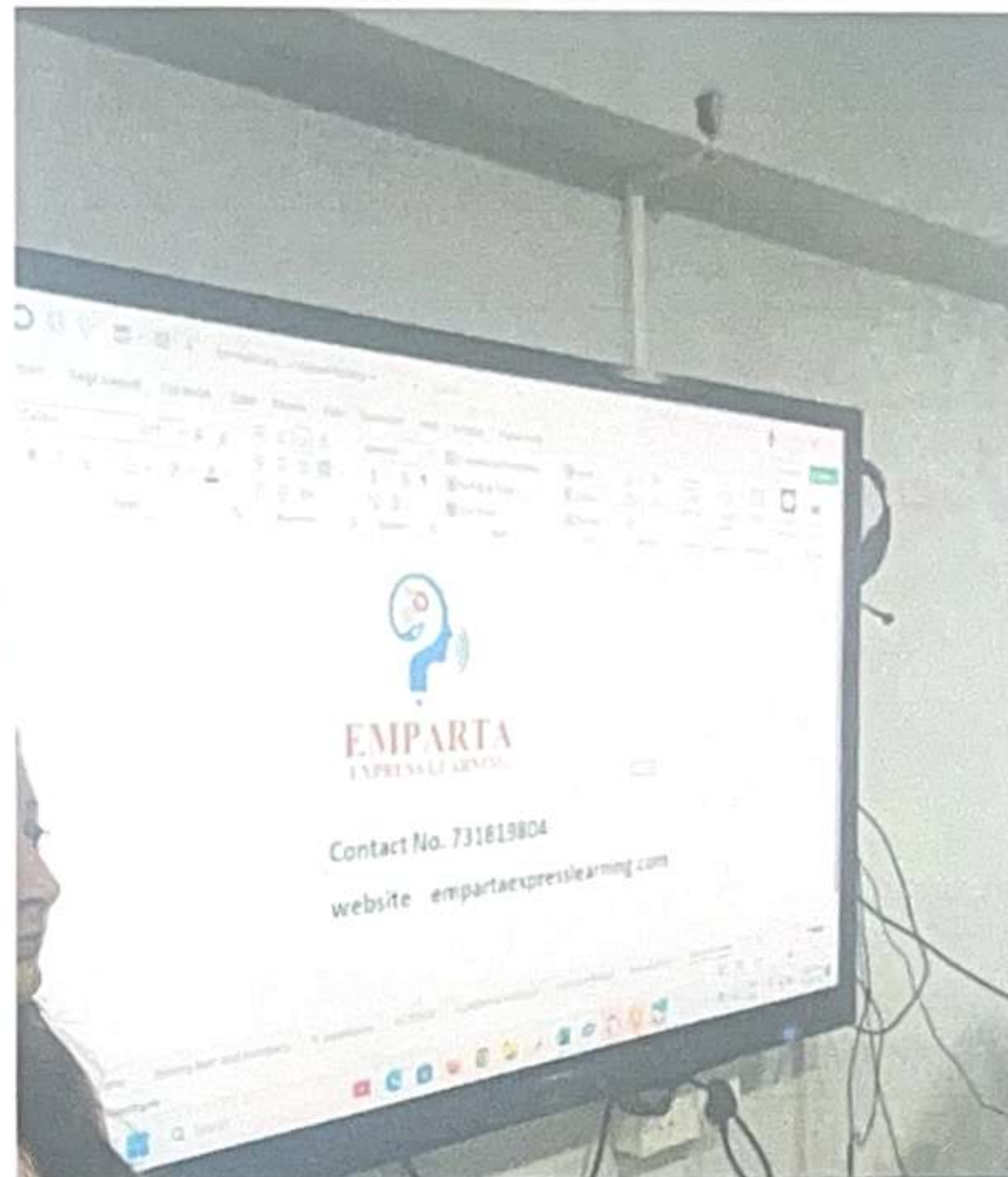
This visit marked a meaningful step towards community upliftment, effectively reinforcing the spirit of social responsibility among the students of LPCPS.

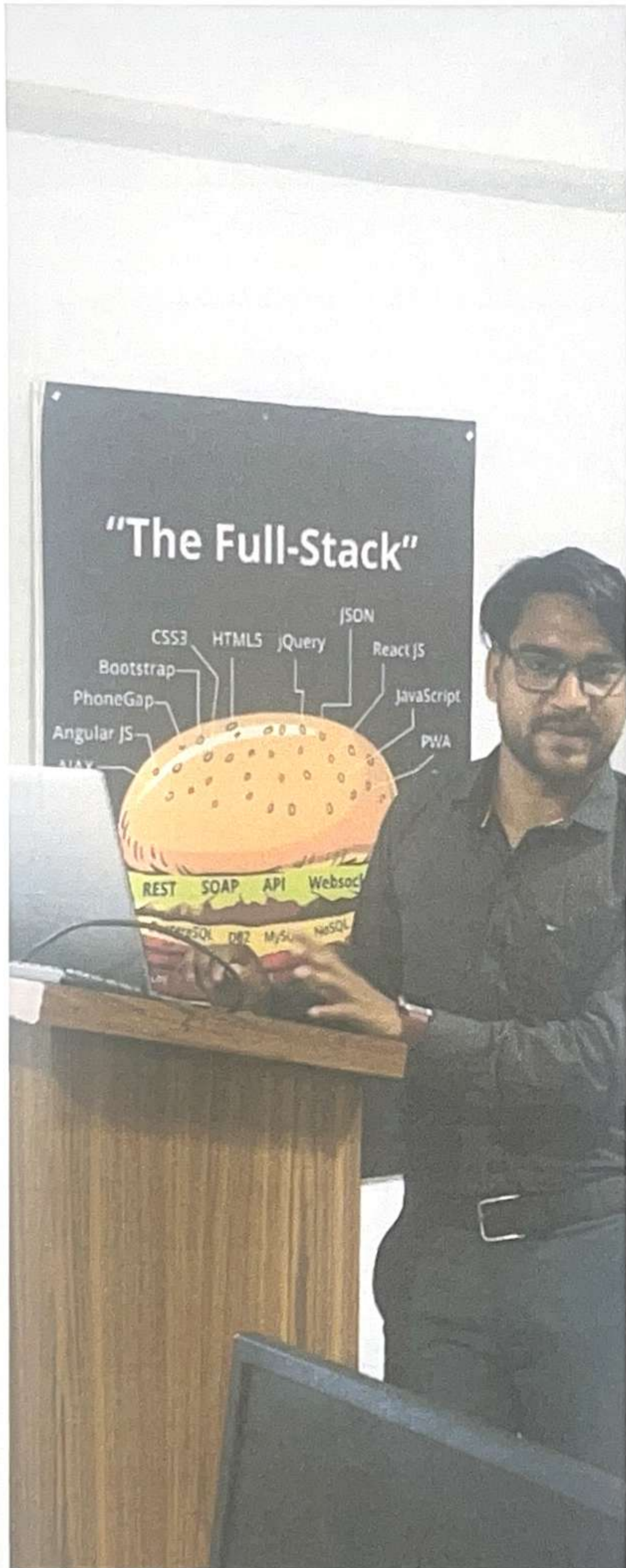

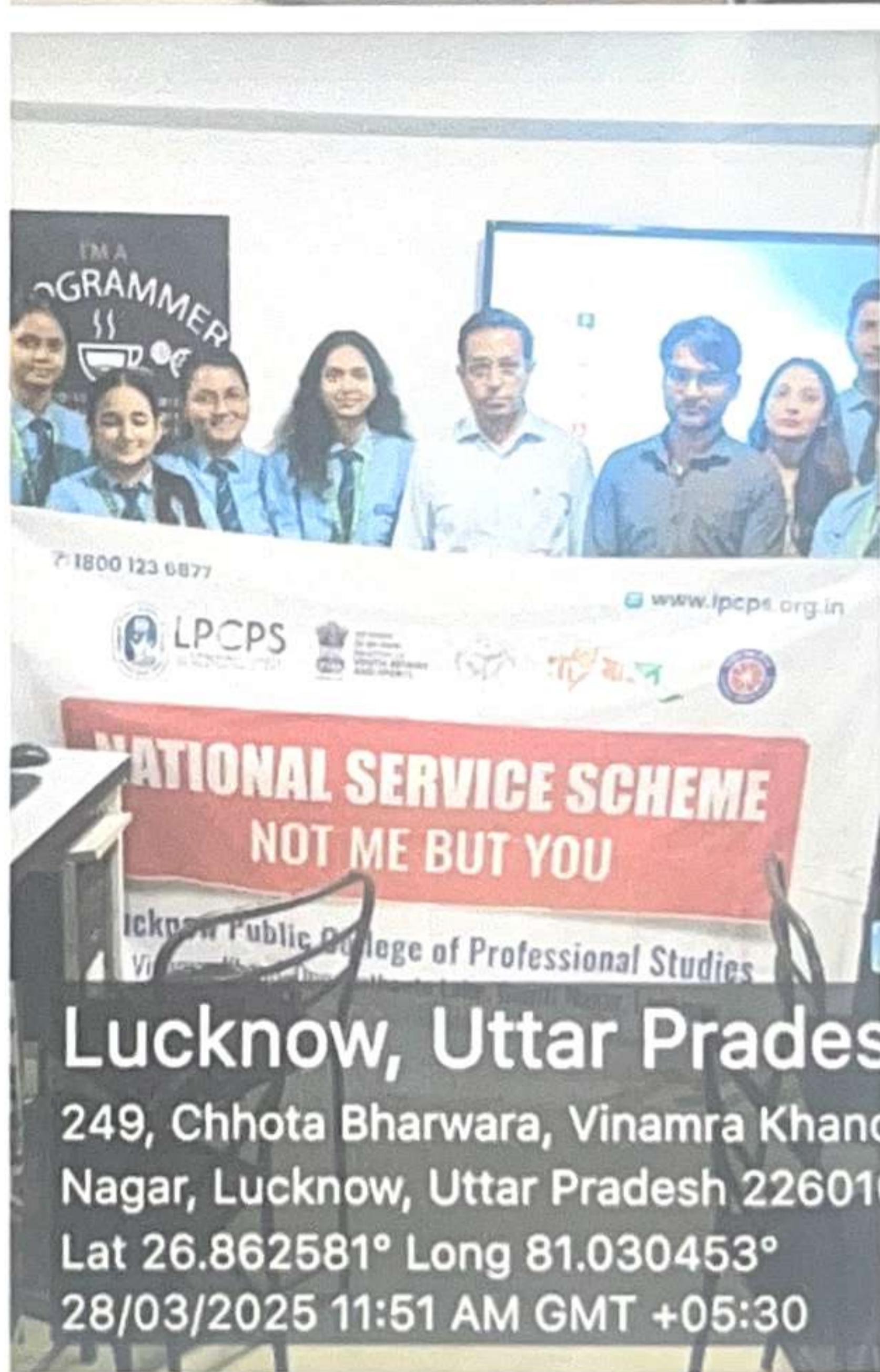

## **Advanced Excel Boot Camp (Phase – 1) for B.Com (Hons.) Students**



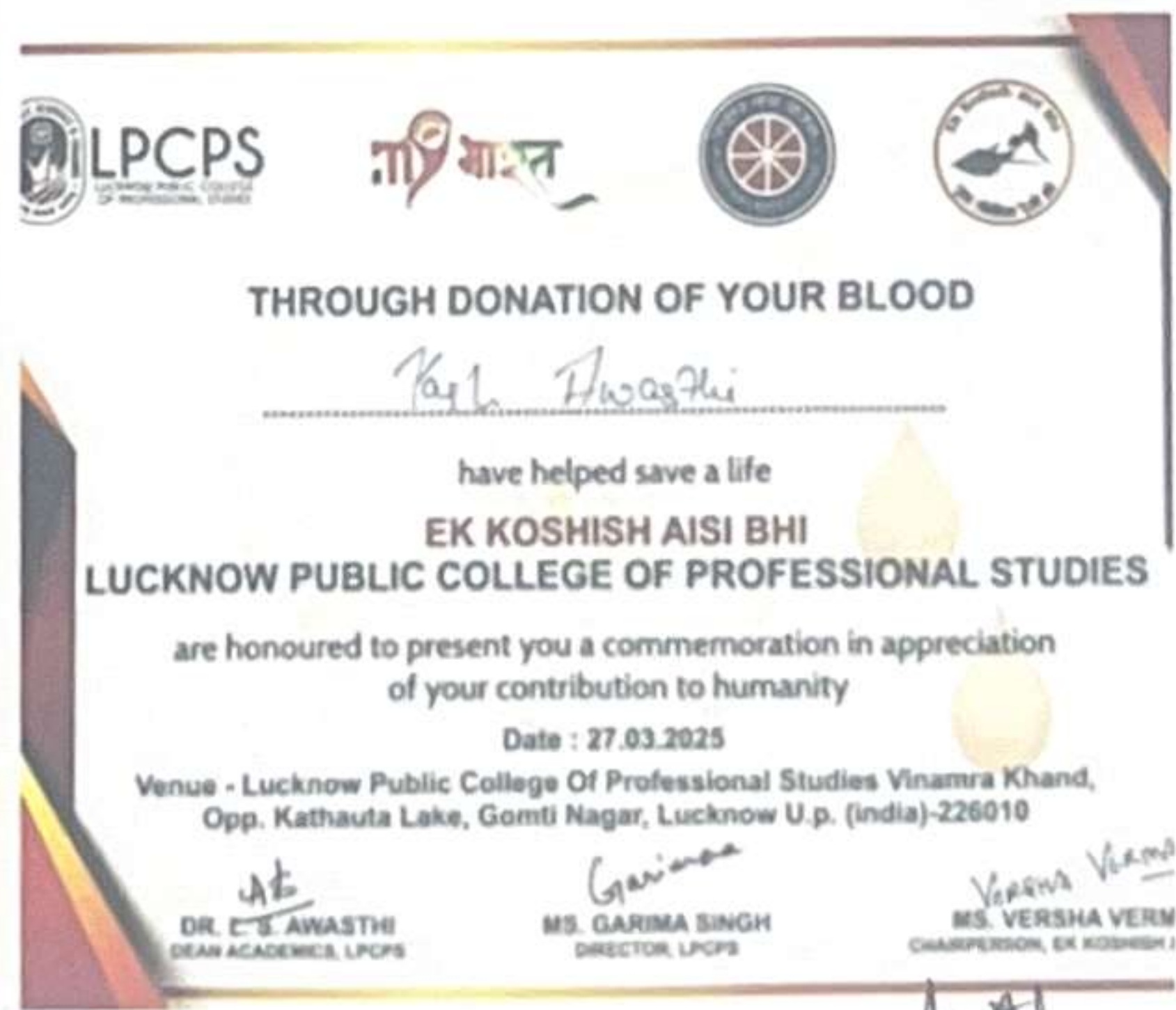
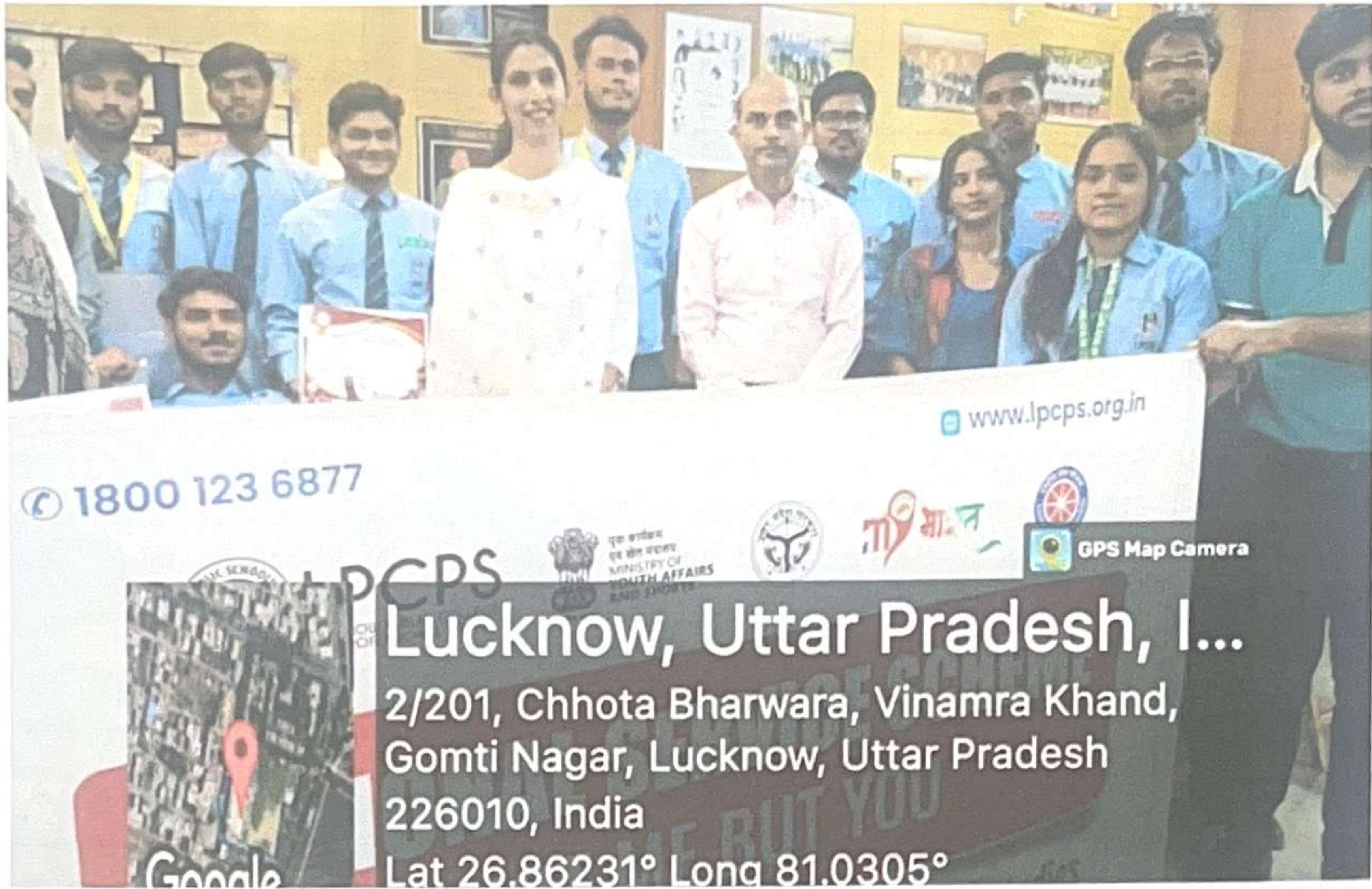
