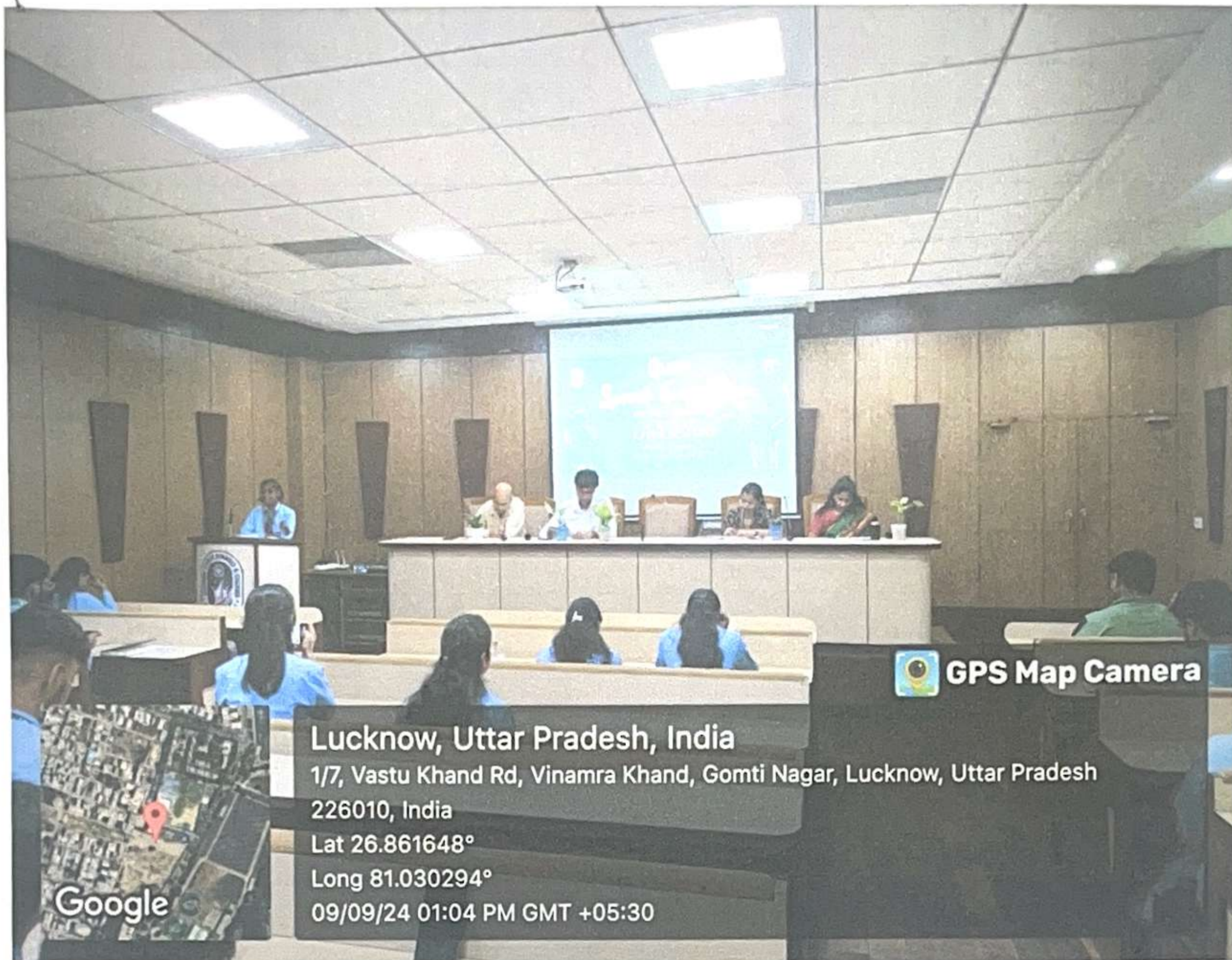



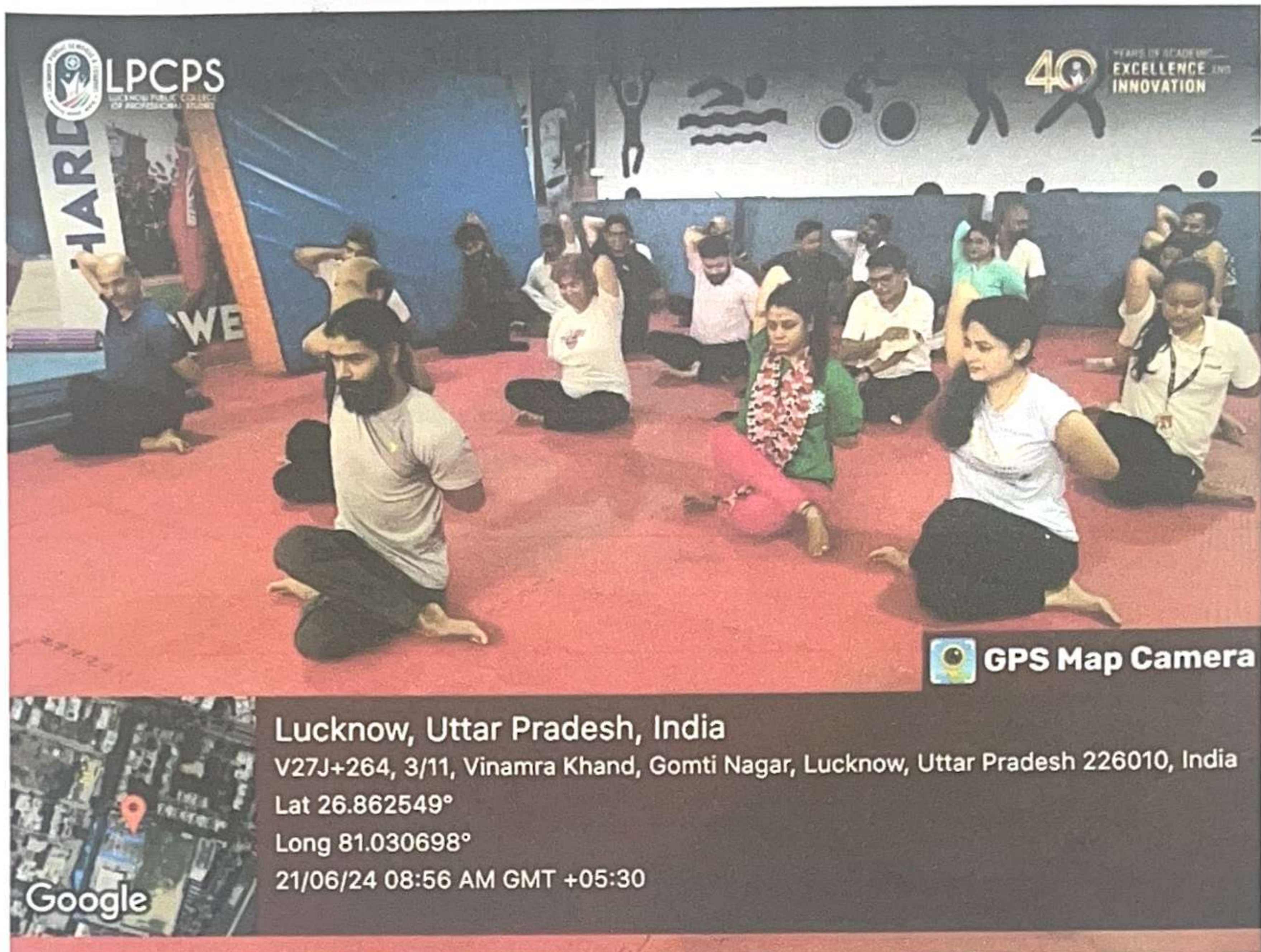


World Literacy Day Speech Competition

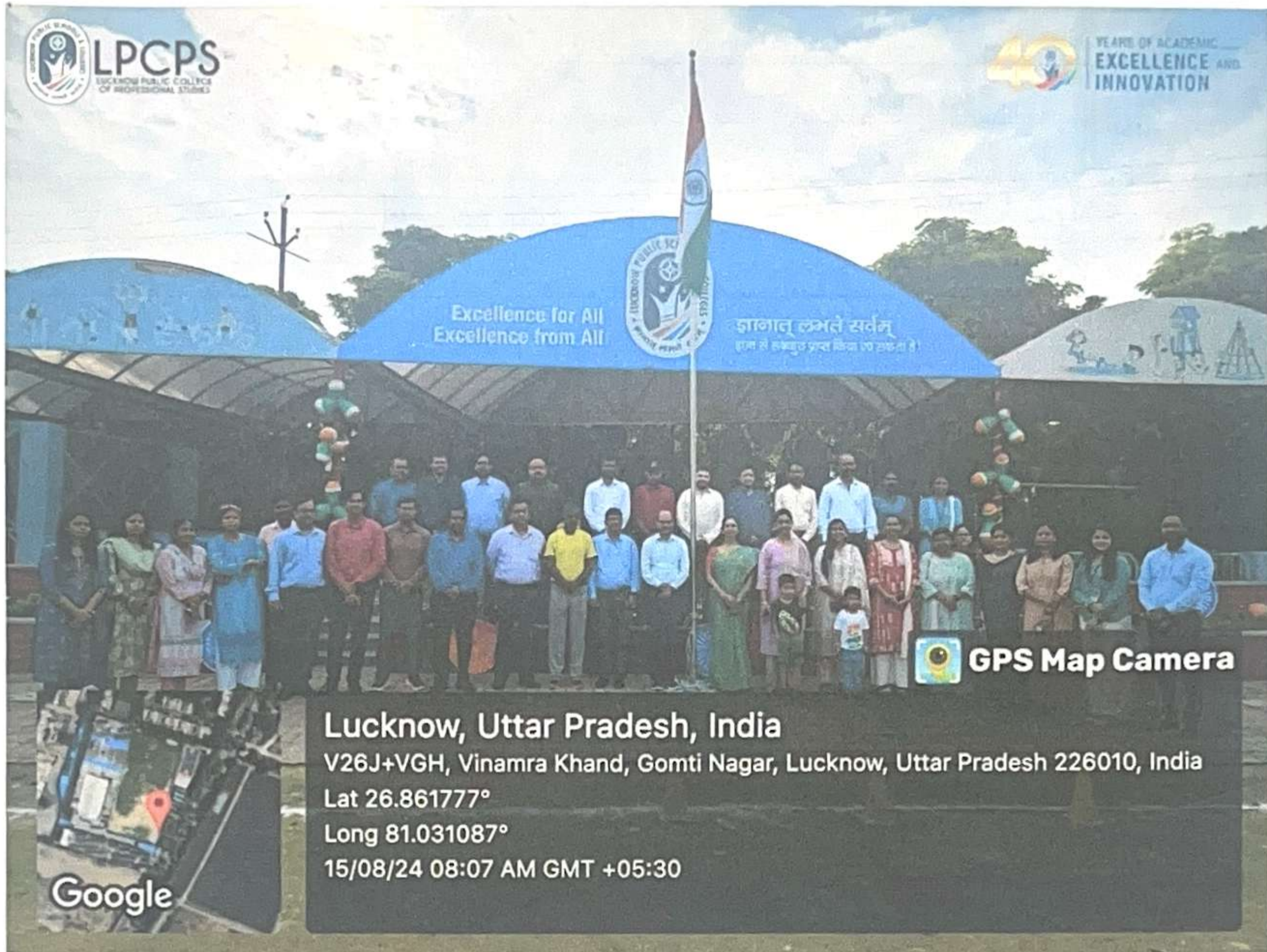


International Yoga Day Celebration



Children's Day Meditation Session

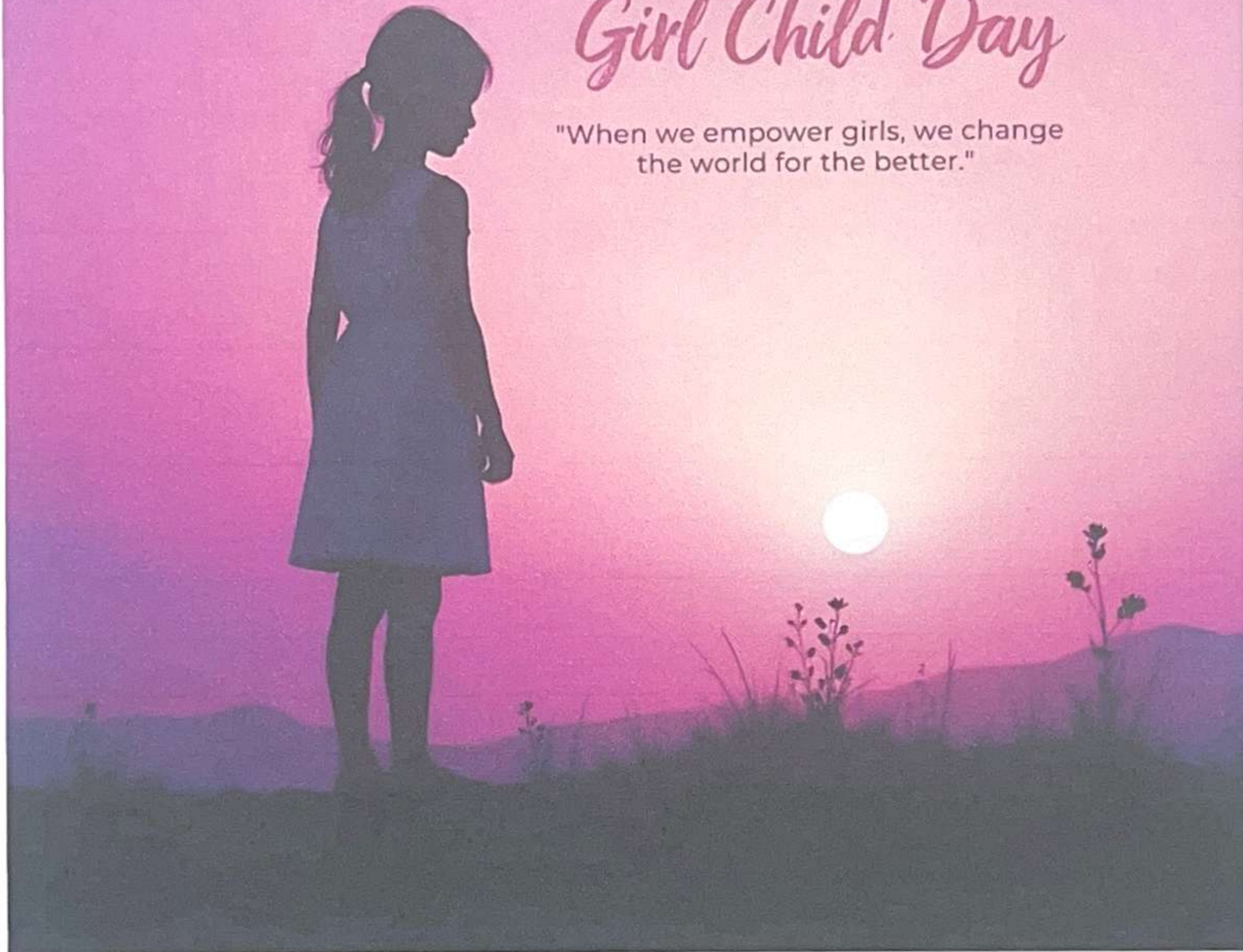



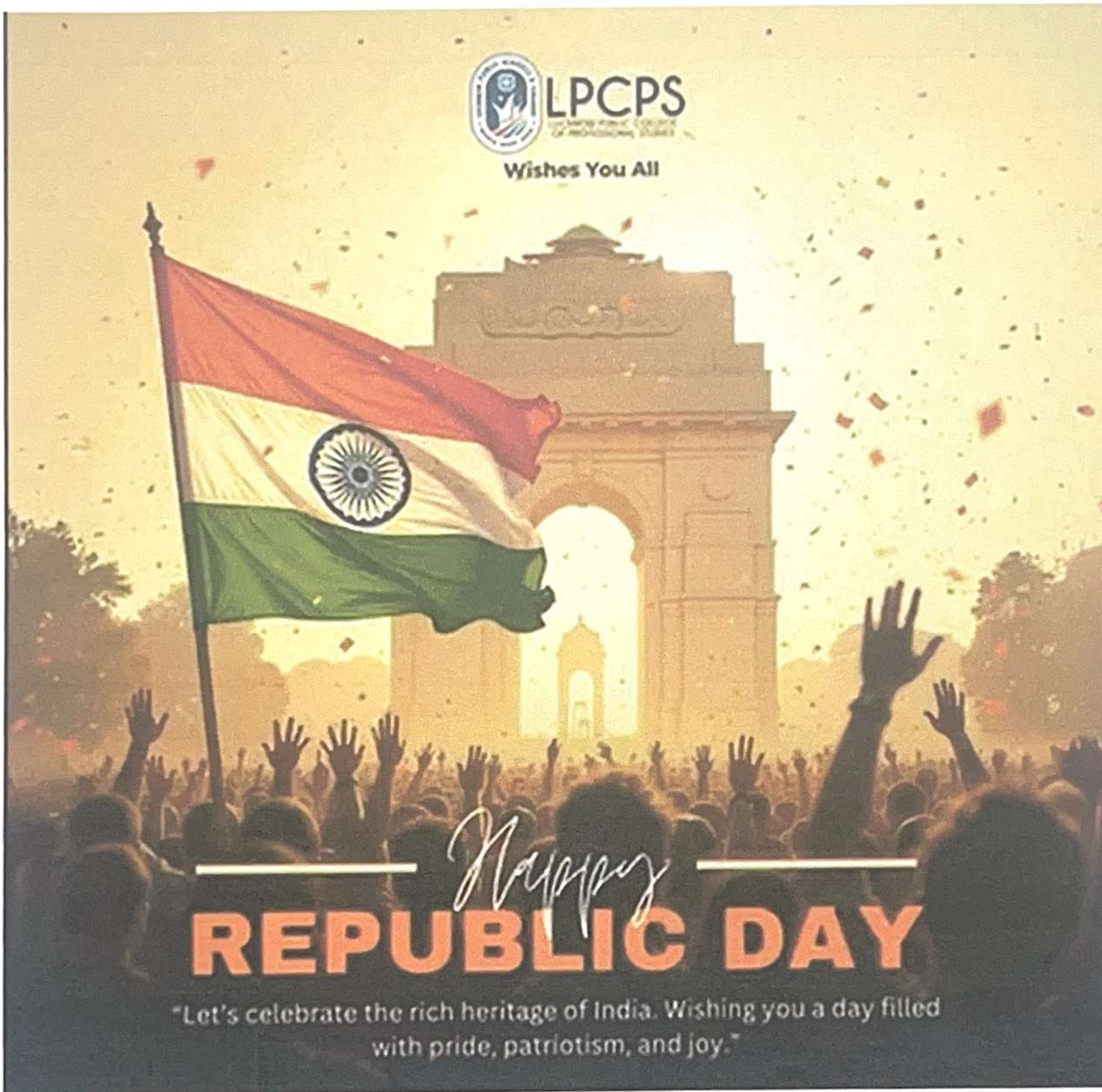
National Girl Child Day Celebration


