
VASANT PANCHAMI




SESSION ON THE OCCASION OF HANUMAN JANMOTSAV


INDEPENDENCE DAY

SESSION ON 'ROLE OF SOCIAL MEDIA IN PROMOTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS'



WORLD LAUGHTER DAY





21 June, 2023: International Yoga Day observed on June 21 aims to raise awareness worldwide of the many benefits of practising yoga.




